We finally were able to identify our grandparents - Edward George Hodgson, and Sarah McLeod.

They had at least 2 daughters,

1. Margaret Elizabeth Hodgson. born Aug. 6, 1900 - 48 Browning St., Bootle cum Linacre. -> Father a 'ship's steward'.
2. Sarah Hodgson (our mother) born Jan 14, 1905 - 30 Hemans St., Bootle cum Linacre. -> Father a 'ship's butcher'.

G'ma Sarah and baby Margaret are on the 1901 census. Boarding at 33 Chaucer St. Bootle. G'ma is reported as being born in Scotland, and being 30 years old at the time of the 1901 census. We have located a Sarah McLeod b. Aug. 16, 1870 (Bracadale, Skye) which fits the timeline

G'pa was not listed on the 1901 census, and we presume he was at sea.

We have a couple of leads for E. G. Hodgson

1. b. Dec. 1865 – Watford, Hertfordshire???
2. b. Jun. 1867 - (1881 Census) (Father William Hodgson age 46 -Mariner? Holyhead /Anglesey/ Wales) - a son listed as Edward being 14 years old. (other children listed as William (jr.), Thomas, Elisah, Lily)

The William Hodgson (age 55) family moved to Liscard/ Wallasey/ Lancaster for the 1891 census, Edward does not appear on 1891 Census.

We have acquired an entry of death for E. G. Hodgson. Died Feb. 17, 1905 aged 37 (Reg. District West Derby, sub-District Bootle, in County of Lancashire.)

We are on the lookout for Marriage and other data.
